Subject: Allocation of foodgrains to States/UTs under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for the 1st Quarter (April, 2018 to June, 2018) for financial year 2018-19.

The undersigned is directed to say that the meeting of the Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) was held on 30 th November, 2017 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Expenditure) to consider the continuation of Mid Day Meal Scheme during 2017-18 to 2019-20. The EFC approved the implementation of the scheme till 2019-20 with a Central Share of Rs. 34000 Cr.

- 2. The draft CCEA note prepared as per the recommendations of the EFC has been approved by the Hon'ble, Human Resource Development Minister. The duly approved and signed draft CCEA note was emailed to Joint Secretary (PF-CII), Department of Expenditure on 13th March, 2016 for obtaining the approval of Hon'ble Finance Minister.
- 3. Department of Expenditure vide OM dated 8.3.2018 has also conveyed that for all ongoing schemes, for which the EFC memorandums are in circulation for inter-ministerial consultations, a further interim extension is granted up to 31st March, 2018 or the date of approval of the competent authority, whichever is later.
- 4. The Mid-Day Meal Scheme is a rights based scheme under National Food Security Act, 2013. Therefore, hot cooked Mid day meal has to be served to the children under the scheme on all school working days failing which Food Security Allowance as per the provisions of the Act has to be paid to the eligible children.
- 5. In view of the position explained above, the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution is therefore requested to allocate 449100.77 MTs (60415.91 MTs Wheat and 388684.86 MTs Rice) of foodgrains to the States/UTs for the 1st quarter of the year 2018-19, under Mid Day Meal Scheme and direct FCI to issue order to different Zonal/ Regional Officers for issuance of foodgrains from 19th March, 2018. Statewise allocation of food grains for the 1st quarter is enclosed. The said allocation has been proposed on the basis of on the number of children and working days (for 1st quarter of the year) approved by PAB-MDM for the year 2017-18. The firm and final allocation of foodgrains for last nine months will be worked out after the PAB-MDM approves the number of children and school days for the financial year 2018-19 and after adjusting the unspent balance of foodgrains reported by States & UTs as on 01.04.2018 from the last years allocation. Collecting information about actual utilization at school level and determining unspent balance in the States/Uts takes about 3 months. Therefore, adhoc allocation for 1st quarter is required to be done now for the smooth implementation of the Scheme without any interruption.

6. This issues with the approval of Joint Secretary (EE.I), Department of SE&L.
