

Why these Guidelines?

For any logo to be memorable and have the desired recall value, it is imperative that it be reproduced across several media of communication in a consistent manner. The most important elements to be consistently used is the logo, it's colours and the typography. To ensures that the audience experiences the logo in the same manner across all media.

These guidelines have been developed to significantly improve and standardise the visual presentation and application of the logo of Mid Day Meal Scheme.

Who should use this?

It is for the use of personnel responsible for communication or graphic designers or professional printers, who may use the logo. The content is specific and technical. This booklet lays down standard guidelines and practices for the use of logo. There are very few rules but please take the time to read and understand how they work, and how they can be used together to ensure a cohesive visual identity. It is crucial that the logo appears correctly and consistently in every communication

As a technical guide which is meant to inform, the colours as reproduced in this booklet may not be accurate due to limitations of the printing process used. To match the colours during print production, please use the specifications mentioned.

Section - I Logo



The concept is evolved from the idea of a group of children sitting together in a circle and having their meal served hot. Equal importance is given to boys and girls with communal harmony. Orange colour is used for the food plate to represent it as hot and fresh food. It also symbolizes energy, heat and sun. At the bottom of the image a picture of a book is used to bring in the relation of education and mid-day meal program. Overall form also represents the shape of a flower as a symbol of childhood, happiness, healthiness, progress and well being of the future generation. The logo is visually balanced using the form of children, book and logo text in Hindi and in English.

Guidelines for application of "Mid-day Meal Symbol"

- The logo should be use in the form as it is provided in the CD.
- Please don't use any other regional language instead of Hindi. Always use Hindi as used
 in a logo. The typo used is bilingual Hindi as its a Flagship Programme and English as
 it's a global language.
- Please do not use any other fonts, colours or change the spacing between logo and typo
 or change the placement of typo (vertically or horizontally), always use the files provided
 in a CD.





Always keep the white space/safe zone measuring the 'x' height from all four corners of the Logo as shown above, to enhance the visibility of the Logo, when places in an any layout/format or coloured/textured background.

The white area kept around the logo is, it's safe zone/white space/breathing space.

Vector file:

Vector image can be enlarged to any size without losing its clarity in terms of colours and fineness of lines.

Minimum size of the logo is 3 cm with typo. Please don't use the logo less than this mentioned height to ensure the visibility of the logo.

Always use the cdr file as provided in a CD for printing and jpg file for the usage in a website or a presentation.







